**RE: Request for Highschool Student Greeters – 2018 General Local and School Board Elections**

As you are aware, the General Local and School Board Elections will be held on Saturday, October 2018 to elect one Mayor, eight Councillors and three SD63 School Trustees. The District of Saanich would like to engage students and future voters in the upcoming election process and we are looking for students to work as "greeters" at our various voting locations.

Greeters will be responsible for welcoming the voter into the voting location and directing them to the appropriate staff in order to receive their ballot. They may also be required to take on other related duties as directed by the Presiding Election Official.

This will be a paid position; \$100 for a six-hour shift from either 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. OR 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday, October 20, 2018. Students will also be required to attend a one-hour training session prior to working on voting day and will be compensated an additional \$20.

The qualifications for this position are as follows:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must not be related to or involved in the campaign for any of the candidates
- Good communication skills
- A second language would be helpful
