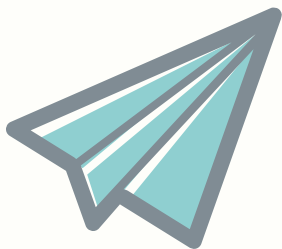

HOT TIPS ON WAGES & GETTING PAID IN BC

- As of June 1, 2018 minimum wage is **\$12.65/hr** and **\$11.40/hr** for liquor servers. On June 1, 2019 these will rise to \$13.85/hr and \$12.70/hr
- You should never have to start work early or stay at work late without pay!
- If you work 15 out of 30 days before a stat holiday and you have been employed for at least 30 days, you are eligible for **stat holidays**.
- Employers must provide a **pay stub** each payday showing the hours worked (rates of pay, overtime pay, total earnings and deductions). If you quit or get fired, your employer must keep payroll records for at least 2 years.
- A **pay period** cannot be longer than 16 days, and you must receive your pay within 8 days of the end of the pay period.
- You must be paid for all **training** you are required to do for work.
- If you are required to wear a **uniform** at work, your employer must give it to you. Your employer must clean it at no cost to you. A dress code is not typically considered a uniform.
