Re: Request for Highschool Student Greeters – 2022 General Local and School Board Elections

As you are aware, the General Local and School Board Elections will be held on Saturday, October 15, 2022 to elect one Mayor, eight Councillors and two SD63 School Trustees. The District of Central Saanich would like to engage students and future voters in the upcoming election process and we are looking for students to work as 'greeters' at our various voting locations.

Greeters will be responsible for welcoming the voter into the voting location and directing them to the appropriate staff to receive their ballot. They may also be required to take on other related duties as directed by the Presiding Election Official.

This will be a paid position- \$125 for a six-hour shift from either 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. OR 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Students will also be required to attending a one-hour training session prior to working on General Voting Day – these sessions will be either Tuesday, September 20 from 6:30 p.m.- 8:30 p.m. or Monday, September 26 from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. Voting locations will be at: Municipal Hall (1903 Mount Newton Cross Road); Cultural Center (1209 Clarke Rd); and Keating Elementary (6843 Central Saanich Rd). The qualifications for this position are as follows:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must not be related to or involved in the campaign for any of the candidates
- Good communications skills
- A second language would be helpful

It would be appreciated if you could circulate this request within your secondary schools. Attached is an application form that each student will be asked to complete by Thursday, September 15, 2022. The completed form can be emailed to elections@csaanich.ca
