RE: Request for High School Student Greeters – 2022 General Local and School Board Elections

As you are aware, the General Local and School Board Elections will be held on Saturday, October 15, 2022. The District of Saanich would like to engage students and future voters in the upcoming election process and we are looking for students to work as "greeters" at our various voting locations.

Greeters will be responsible for welcoming the voter into the voting location and directing them to the appropriate staff in order to receive their ballot. They may also be required to take on other related duties as directed by the Presiding Election Official.

This will be a paid position; \$125 for a six-hour shift from either 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. OR 2 p.m. to 8 p.m. on Saturday, October 15, 2022. Students will also be required to attend a one-hour training session prior to working on voting day and will be compensated an additional \$25.


The qualifications for this position are as follows:

- Must be 16 years of age or older
- Must not be related to or involved in the campaign for any of the candidates
- Good communication skills
- A second language would be helpful

It would be appreciated if you could circulate this request within your secondary schools. Attached is an application form that each student will be asked to complete by Friday, September 16, 2022. The completed form can be emailed to elections@saanich.ca.
