- Sharpens hockey and figure skates, including rental skates and patron skates.
- Hands out rental skates, ensuring skates are in good repair and the correct size.
- Works cohesively with other program staff, maintenance, and reception.
- Maintains safe work practices.
- Follows all policies, procedures and standards of the CRD.
- Performs other related duties as required.

Qualifications

- Experience with figure skating, ice skating or hockey.
- Ability to sharpen skates using machinery.
- Strong, confident skating and/or hockey skills.
- Enjoy working with children and/or adults.
- Ability to establish rapport with children.
- Willingness and ability to work flexible hours including evenings, weekends (ability to work some daytime shifts an asset).
- Emergency First Aid with CPR C (or willingness to obtain).
