6 1/2 Hour Work Study Program - FAQ

1. Is signing a release normal?

Yes, the attached release is a generic release form used by the BC Army Reserve and the Canadian Armed Forces as a whole for all events involving minors.

2. Who are the supervisors / instructors?

Each group will be led by a Section Commander who is typically the rank of Sergeant. Sergeants are Senior Non-Commissioned Officers who are experienced supervisors and trainers. Each of our Section Commanders has considerable experience teaching Basic Military Qualification Courses with BC Army Reserve members the same age as the Soldier for a Day attendees.

3. How will I know if I am accepted into the program?

Registration on Event Brite will be confirmed through e-mail. Please remember to complete the required paperwork* and bring it with you the day of the event.

4. Are parents welcome?

Yes, parents, guardians, teachers, career counsellors, and any other school faculty are welcome to spectate if they wish. The majority of parents choose to drop their children off in the morning, before 0900hrs and pick them up at 1600hrs (4:00 pm)

Every year we have parents, guardians, teachers, career counsellors, and other school faculty register themselves to take part in the work study program. Your participation is highly encouraged.

5. Does the Program involve a transport plan for attendees?

No, attendees are responsible for their own transport to and from the event location. Most attendees are dropped off via motor vehicle; some arrange car pools for groups of students from the same high school, and some attendees use public transit or other means.

6. Do Attendees have to bring anything with them to the event?

- **a.** Attendees must bring Picture ID (Gov't issued ID or School ID for those without)
- **b.** Appropriate clothing for the weather as some stands may be outside; and
- c. Any required personal protective equipment will be supplied by the SFAD staff.
