## **Topic:**

• Choose a trade or technology career and tell/show us how some of the Skills for Success are used for this career.

### **Contest Details:**

- There will be **two group**: Grades 9 to 12 and Post-Secondary.
- The winners of each category will receive a \$75 e-gift card.
- The deadline to enter is by October 15, 2021 at 6:00 PM PST.

### **Challenge Materials:**

- Computers can be laptops or desktops. Must be able to export a 720p/1080p H.264 file (.mov/.m4v/.mp4).
- You are responsible for any software you wish to use, as well as any required accessories (power adapter, keyboard, mouse, monitors, headphones, etc.).
- Video Cameras or Mobile Device.
- Microphones and Audio Recording Devices.
- Tripods, Monopods, Handheld Stabilizers (no rails, jibs or sliders).
- No Drones.
- Copyright free and Royalty free Music is allowed. You may create your own soundtrack using software on your computer
- You may record interviews using Skype, Microsoft Teams, and use capture recording software like OBS Open Broadcaster Software to record the interview <a href="https://obsproject.com/">https://obsproject.com/</a>

## **Challenge Instructions:**

- File size must be under 1GB
- Accepted file types: .mov/.m4v/.mp4 and mkv.
- Competitors can submit a minimum 720p to max 1080p video in a H.264 file.
- Time Requirement: Video length is to be 60-120 seconds
- Brand logos should not be the centre of focus in any shot or should be blurred if present.
- No footage captured prior to the competition is allowed to be used. All footage used in the video should be filmed within the video submission time frame and not belong to any other creator.

- To Register and Send/Upload your Photos, go to <u>https://skillscanada.bc.ca/video-production-challenge-2/</u> to complete the form, click BROWSE FILES and upload the video. Don't forget to click SUBMIT when you are done.
- Photos and/or videos will be posted to Skills Canada BC social media platforms.

- Any offensive photos and/or those that request their photos not be shared, will not be posted and are automatically disqualified.
