Application & Transcript Deadlines

The application deadline for current grade 12 students to qualify for <u>conditional admission</u> is **May 15th**. Students can apply through <u>EducationPlannerBC</u>. The deadline for students to submit official transcripts showing interim grades through the <u>StudentTranscripts Service</u> is **May 16th**.

Fall 2023 Registration Timeline

The <u>course catalogue</u> for the Fall 2023 term will be released on **May 31**st. Once the course catalogue is released, students can begin planning their course schedule for the Fall term to prepare for their registration date.

On **May 31**st, students who have accepted an Offer of Admission by paying their registration deposit will be assigned a registration date that can be found on their <u>myCamosun</u>. Course registration for the Fall 2023 term will begin the week of **June 19**th – **22**nd.

A step-by-step guide through the registration process can be found here. We encourage all students to review the process now so that everything runs smoothly on their registration date. If students would like support with program planning and course selection for the Fall term, they can complete the contact form to request an appointment with an Academic Advisor.

Students who have applied for limited enrolment programs will not follow the outlined timeline as they will receive specific registration information after they have accepted an offer of admission.

Now: Students can log into their <u>myCamosun</u> to pay their \$175 deposit, this deposit must be paid before students will be able to register into courses

May 31st: Fall 2023 course catalogue goes live and students can begin planning their schedules

May 31st: Registration dates posted on myCamosun for those who have accepted their Offer

June 19th: Fall 2023 registration begins in priority sequence

June 23rd: Fall 2023 registration open for all students, ongoing

Scholarship & Bursary Applications

Most students need help paying for post-secondary education. Our <u>Financial Aid & Awards</u> webpage has information about funding options including government student loans and Camosun bursaries, awards, and scholarships.

<u>Entrance Award and Bursary</u> applications are open from **May 1**st **to August 1**st. We encourage students to be aware of the award criteria and application process before applying. Students have to apply for each award separately.

<u>General Camosun Bursary</u> applications for the Fall 2023 term are open from **September 5**th **to October 17**th. Students only need to submit one general bursary application per term to be considered for over 300 bursaries.

Program Highlight: University Transfer

The <u>University Transfer</u> program is our general studies option. When students apply for University Transfer, they will choose one of four specialties to start: Arts, Business, Education, or Science. Regardless of which specialty a student chooses, they will be welcome to select courses from any of the four categories, as long as they have the appropriate course prerequisites. The University Transfer program lets students mix and match their credit courses to create an educational plan that's right for them.

The University Transfer program can be a starting point for students who would like to take a variety of courses to explore their personal interests, those who need to take courses to satisfy the admission requirements for another program, or those who plan to get their Bachelor's Degree but would like to start their studies at college. It is our most flexible and customizable program with options for full-time or part-time studies.

Current grade 12 students can apply for this program through <u>EducationPlannerBC</u> until May 15th to be considered for conditional admission.
