Dear Parent/Guardian,

Island Health's Medical Imaging Open House for High School Students is an initiative developed by Island Health's Medical Imaging department. This program encourages Medical Imaging departments across Island Health to host high school students who have expressed an interest in working in a hospital career to attend a 1.5 hour information session that promotes the MRT's professions – X-ray, CT, MRI, and Nuclear Medicine.

Island Health wishes to provide an opportunity to invest in the future by helping youth in the local school districts explore careers in healthcare services. The students will attend a short information session and tour medical imaging departments. The objective of this program is to enhance student awareness and career planning options by developing an understanding and appreciation of potential health services careers.

Student will attend a 1.5 hour long information session at their local Island Health site, which will include a half hour introductory presentation, a half hour tour of X-ray, computed tomography or fluoroscopy scan room and finish with a half hour question and answer period with Island Health's Medical Imaging staff.

It is also important that students ensure that their basic immunizations are up-to-date and be healthy on the day of the visit.

During their visit to an Island Health facility, the visiting students will not have any direct patient interaction and will not be observing any patient care activities. They will also not have access to any patient information or files.

Students will be required to dress appropriately as a visitor in a health care setting. No open-toed shoes, shorts or inappropriate T-shirts will be permitted. They must wear a "Visitor" identification badge sticker at all times.
