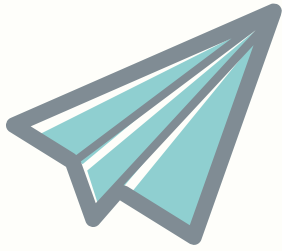

HOT TIPS ON WHAT TO DO BEFORE YOU START YOUR JOB SEARCH

- **Get a Social Insurance Number (SIN)** - Your SIN is a nine-digit number that you need to legally work in Canada. Youth who are 12 years of age or older may apply for their own SIN. You must provide a valid primary document that proves your identity and legal status in Canada (such as your Birth Certificate). There is no fee to apply for your SIN. Head to **Service Canada** for more information.
- **Create a Professional Email** - when applying for jobs, it is important to use an email that is clear and professional (such as your first and last name). We often recommend creating an email just for your job search to help you keep track of where you applied, and streamline all your professional communication.
- **Clean up Your Social Media** - prospective employers may do their own research of you before calling you in for an interview. So ensure your Social Media accounts are set to Private, and that you clean up any...inappropriate content. You will thank us later!
